Dear Turgut:

Earlier today we spoke about your departure from the US.

I let you know that ICE has agreed that you may leave the US today.

You will need to take the I-392 form that I emailed you earlier today, to the US Embassy in Istanbul when you arrive there. Present that document to the embassy and ask that the embassy verify your presence in Turkey.

You will need to provide this proof that you left the US, in order for ICE to cancel the bond it set for you, and return the bond money.

I also let you know that your passport was available for you to pick up at ICE's office in Tukwila this morning. You declined to retrieve your passport and have asked me to retrieve it for you.

I am not convinced that ICE will provide me with your passport but I will request it on your behalf, and forward it to your family if ICE provides it for me.
