Petitioner Mr. Turgut Tarhan asks the Court for a twenty-one day extension of time, until December 22, 2011, to file a Petition For Rehearing and Petition for Rehearing En Banc.

The Court denied Mr. Tarhan's Petition for Review on 17 October, 2011. A Petition for Rehearing and/or Petition for Hearing En Banc is due on 1 December 2011.


